115.01 PROCLAMATIONS; ISSUANCE AND CONTENT.

Whenever, pursuant to Section 7 of the City Charter, the Mayor issues a proclamation declaring a state of public danger and emergency to exist in the City, such proclamation shall state the presence of such danger and emergency; the causes therefor, if known; the period during which such proclamation shall be in force and effect; the rules, regulations and directives to be followed by persons in the City; and the specific prohibitions of action, if any, by persons in the City during the period of such proclamation.

115.02 PUBLICATION BY CLERK.

It shall be the duty of the Clerk of the City Commission to cause such proclamation to be published, in full, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City within ten days after the issuance thereof.

115.03 VIOLATION A MISDEMEANOR.

No person, firm, or corporation shall violate any specific rule, regulation, directive or prohibition of any proclamation issued by the Mayor pursuant to Section 7 of the City Charter and Section 115.01.

115.04 REPORT TO COMMISSION.

It shall be the duty of the Mayor to make a report of such proclamation to the City Commission at the first regular meeting of the City Commission held after the issuance thereof. Such report shall be placed upon the journal record of the City Commission.

115.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates Section 115.03 is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree.
