4. Caps shall not be left off of unattended fire hydrants.
5. The applicant shall pay any and all damage resulting from the use of the above referenced hydrant.
6. Meter must be returned by permit expiration date listed above.
7. Charges for water are waived on City sponsored projects. Inspection and deposit fees may be required.
8. The City Manager or designee must approve any changes in the above stated requirements.
