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Springfield Releases Water Quality Consumer Confidence Report for 2016

SPRINGFIELD, OHIO – May 31, 2017 – The City of Springfield’s annual Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) will be delivered to water customers in this month’s utility bill. Customers who do not receive a utility bill can view the report by visiting the Springfield website at www.springfieldohio.gov.

The CCR is the City’s annual water quality report that includes information on the drinking water source, analytical results of contaminant testing, and regulatory compliance and educational information. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires water systems to provide this annual report to its consumers under the Safe Drinking Water Act.

Employees of the Springfield Water Treatment Plant care about the quality of the drinking water they provide. They work hard to supply all of the City’s customers with drinking water that meets or exceeds the safety and quality standards set by the state and federal governments.

“The City of Springfield is proud to provide high quality water to its residents,” said Springfield City Manager Jim Bodenmiller. “We are dedicated to being transparent with them and are pleased to once again release a positive annual report.”
