**W. First Street:**

On Monday, May 20, 2019, W. First Street will be closed at the railroad tracks west of Universal Drive for an emergency rail repair. This closure will in effect beginning at 7am and will be closed till late evening.

**Road will be reopened on Tuesday, May 21, 2019.**

**N. Bechtle Avenue:**

On Thursday, May 23, 2019, N. Bechtle Avenue will be closed south of the railroad tracks near Perry Street for an emergency rail repair. A detour utilizing US 68 will be posted.

**Road will be reopened on Friday, May 24, 2019.**

**E. Harding Road:**

Traffic will be one way, westbound. This will be in effect for the remainder of the project.

**Anticipated completion date is July 26, 2019**

**Bechtle Avenue (over Snyder Park Road):**

Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction on Bechtle Avenue from Keifer Avenue to Perry Street. A detour will be posted for closure of Snyder Park Road under Bechtle Bridge.

**Anticipated Completion Date: August 30, 2019**
