City to Hold Public Forum on South Limestone Redevelopment

City of Springfield officials are asking for public participation in a discussion on July 30 about redevelopment of the South Limestone corridor.

The City recently entered into a Letter of Intent with developer Larry Dillin as a preliminary step toward redeveloping the former South Limestone Kroger site and surrounding area, said Logan Cobbs, Assistant to the City Manager.

“It’s vital that we have a public forum on this issue so the community is able to give us their input on the future of the neighborhood,” said Cobbs. “Community engagement is key to everything that the City and its partners do to make Springfield an even better place to live, work and play.”

Organizers of the public forum will address redevelopment opportunities and collect input from citizen participants. The meeting will take place on the virtual platform ZOOM at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, July 30.
