Global Education Speaker Series and Calendar for 2020-2021 Revealed

The Global Education and Peace Network (GEPC) will hold the first program in its Global Education Speaker Series, “Connecting through the Distance: Practicing Faith Hope and Love in Pandemic Times,” on Zoom Thursday, Sept. 10 at 6:30 p.m. Speakers for the 2020-2021 series will be introduced, and each will explore questions of how their faith traditions are responding to the COVID-19 pandemic and racism.

Those presenting will include a representative of the Hindu Community of Springfield, Roi Qualls of the Baha’i Community of Yellow Springs, Rabbi Cary Kozberg of Temple Sholom, Lillian White of St. Bernard Catholic Church, Samina Ahmed of the Masjid Al-Madina Mosque, a representative of the Sikh tradition and Rev. Dale DeGroat of Second Baptist Church. Following the brief presentations, there will be time for discussion.
